Programming

- Storytime- just as we were wrapping up storytimes before summer, we suddenly got some regulars. They came every week in May, and actually have continued to come as we have left off regular storytime and transitioned into summer crafts and activities. I hope they will be back in September!
- Book Group- We chose translations as our theme for May. The books discussed were:
 - Madiq Alley by Naguib Mahfouz
 - I Want to Die But I Want to Eat Tteokbokki by Baek Se-hee
 - The Little Prince by Antoine de Sainte-Exupery
 - Anxious People by Frederik Backman

Next month's theme will be books published in the past year (or 2).

- STEM stuff- I was able to get a \$500 grant to buy supplies to do STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) programs this summer. It will be fun to find ways to spend it! I also attended a training for the new STEM trailers that are now available from the Idaho Out of School Network. There is a fully stocked trailer in Gooding, and we can borrow it for more activities. Jodie Ward from the school's afterschool program was also there, and we have reserved the trailer for October so both we and the school can use it.
- Passive Programming- We did another guessing jar, this time full of sour gummy
 worms. The winner guessed 200, which was only 14 off of the actual number of 186. The
 kids seem to really like it. I'm not going to do one in June, because we want to
 concentrate on getting kids to join up with the Summer Reading Program, but it will
 probably be back in July.

• The Foundation had its quarterly meeting on the 9th. We discussed the County Fair and the raffle and book sale that we always do in conjunction with it. For the raffle, Kayla Bovey told us that her employer has offered to solicit prizes for us as a service to the community. We have a couple of things already found, but this will be a huge help. In addition to our sale here at the Library, Sherrie Gregory has volunteered to have a table over in the 4-H park with a bunch of books she wants to clear out, and she will give us the money. Judith Freeman said she also has a bunch of books to donate to that table. We hope to make a bit of money from selling to people who might not wander over our way.
